



Bob Mosley True Blue

Listen my friends, as SteadyBoy Records announces the release of this Moby Grape-related rarity by the historic psychedelic folk band's bass player, Bob Mosley. The magic of the Moby Grape was the model of the band, with each member writing and singing in a magical collective of like-minded friends creating thoughtful music rooted in blues and rock. They represented the best of the San Francisco scene of the late sixties. Skip Spence and Bob Mosley were the two members who had to battle personal demons, which likely both fueled the band's creativity and hindered its widespread success. But make no mistake: they were a spiritually successful band, and their influence continues. On a fateful day in 1996, while experiencing homelessness, Bob Mosley was picked up on the side of a San Diego freeway by none other than Peter Lewis, his former Moby Grape band mate. That's when Mosley was ready to go back to work. True Blue is the direct result, an album released in Germany in 2005. It lives up to its name, and it finds Mosley in top form, even closing with a great new version of the Grape classic, "Lazy Me." SteadyBoy is as proud to share this lost but not forgotten gem as it was to release a Peter Lewis album several years back. Both releases are important to the Moby Grape story. And this one is true blue.
