


## Shakin' Apostles

It was a gloriously jangly power pop with a western twist that defined the mighty Shakin' Apostles of Austin, Texas in the 1990s. They were musical descendants of Austin music Hall of Famer Freddie Steady Krc's previous band, The Explosives, a tight rocking trio of the prior decade. But as much as Krc (rhymes with search) loved those tight-as-a-drum three-minute rockers, he was equally influenced by the folk rock of Buffalo Springfield, the Byrds, and Moby Grape. The Apostles would be his outlet for a decidedly more western sound. Freddie had also been Jerry Jeff Walker's drummer, so Texas rock came into the mix as well, and it was definitely shakin'. "Wild Wild West" was the quintessential Apostles song, and that's what kicks off this gem of an album, finally available again after nearly two decades. It includes five previously unreleased bonus cuts that capture the band in action on stage. You'll like rockin' in the wild, wild west with the unforgettable Shakin' Apostles.
